Dear Friends,

In March of 2021 we launched the *Strong and Courageous* strategic expansion and capital campaign. The overarching goal of the expansion is to develop how we care for children and increase the number of children in our care. The vision breaks down into three phases: Phase I builds a 13,000 SF multipurpose building and learning center; Phase II builds a third home for children, bringing our capacity to 30; Phase III builds a transitional home for children aging out of WCCH, foster care, and other residential programs.

We are delighted to announce Phase I is 50% funded with \$687,753 - and it has only been 90 days!

Over 175 families, churches, and businesses made monetary donations, pledges and in-kind donations of services/materials. The Christian community has responded strong and courageously, giving sacrificially so that each child can experience hope and restoration. At the Woodburn Christian Children's Home, we do not raise victims; we raise *strong and courageous* children who can overcome life's difficulties.

Join the collective voice – Every child needs a CHAMPION to be Strong and Courageous. Be that champion!

The expansion empowers children physically, emotionally, educationally, and spiritually. For example, Aaron writes, "At WCCH, I learned right from wrong, responsibility, and love. I would never had finish high school if not for WCCH. The most important thing I learned was that Jesus is first in the lives at WCCH. My faith in Christ grew and I enjoyed the love of Christ shown through the actions of my house parents."



The multipurpose building and learning center provides dedicated space for Biblical studies, education, life skill instruction, counseling, fitness, parenting workshops, community interaction, recreation, etc. All of this together enables our staff to cherish each child and teach God's great love and purpose. For example, Klarissa writes, "When I first came to WCCH, I was an angry girl. I came to get away from my family. Now, I learned how fortunate I am to have come to WCCH. It revived my faith in Christ and renewed my relationship with my family. I am more content and happier than I have been in years. I have an appreciation and respect for authority and I love the staff at WCCH."
