Often times children come to WCCH because their behaviors are creating problems at home and school. WCCH believes the key to changing behaviors is understanding the thoughts preceding the behaviors. For children who experience neglect and abuse, this is important because behaviors illustrate trauma. This is similar to how a child's story book uses illustrations to help tell the story. For this reason, the WCCH staff invests considerable time understanding each child's story and the resultant behaviors. The goal is to help them re-write the story in their hearts using the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As the new story of life unfolds in Christ, new behaviors begin to illustrate thoughts of hope, love and obedience. The process takes time: sometimes quickly, sometimes slowly. In either case, our WCCH family is committed to help for however long is needed. Your prayerful support strengthens this resolve. Your ministry extends through WCCH - into the hearts of children.


