Life in ministry connects biblical Truth to everyday experiences. Those serving at Woodburn Christian Children's Home have the privilege of witnessing this integration of life and Truth. The interplay is found around dining room tables and school projects. The connection happens in counseling, sports, and walks in the sun. We see eternal moments in God's world unfold as each child comes to life through Truth.

Teaching Truth to children is a privilege, one we do not take lightly at WCCH. Each staff carefully studies God's Word, preparing themselves to teach Truth. The following reflection by Hal and Carol Rogers is one example of our Biblical teaching ministry.

"Children come to WCCH desperate, hoping that something good may happen; but the kids mostly look in all the wrong places for that hope. Their hope, if expressed, is one of uncertainty. We teach this is *not* the distinctive biblical meaning of hope. Biblical hope is not just a desire for something good in the future, rather, Biblical hope is confident expectation for something good in the future *rooted in God's faithfulness*. Biblical hope not only desires something good but expects it confidently! There is a heart-felt certainty that the good we expect, and desire will be done as written in Hebrews 6:9-12. We teach the kids you may lose hope in others, but the Lord will never let you down. The upcoming resurrection celebration proclaims this confident Hope in God's faithfulness."

I am grateful for the tireless efforts of Hal and Carol. More importantly though, I am thankful for their faith and desire to study God's Word.

I pray you will study the Bible to let loose the Truth in the life of your family through every-day experiences.
